## ***PROGRAM UPDATES***

### **ODH System of Payments Rule Rescission**

With the change of Part C lead agency from ODH to DODD and the new SOP rule that DODD is proposing, ODH is seeking to rescind its EI SOP rule. Details about the public comment process for the rescission accompany this biweekly communication.

### **State Systemic Improvement Plan Phase III, Year 1 Summary**

As described in EI Program Updates #1708, DODD submitted Ohio's Phase III, Year 1 State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) write-up in late March. Throughout year one of Phase III, Ohio completed numerous activities related to achieving short-term outcomes in each of the three improvement strategy areas, which were primarily designed to help the state further identify areas of need and to increase access to useful resources. A summary of the SSIP activities completed and the baseline data analyzed over the past year has been posted on the EI website, as have summaries for the past two SSIP submissions. These documents can be found on the Data and Monitoring page on the "Federal Reporting and Postings" tile.

### **Quarterly Child Outcome Summary Data**

As described in EI Program Updates #1704, DODD will be sending quarterly Child Outcome Summary (COS) files until COS reports are available in Early Track. Files including the most recent quarter of data available, for children who exited EI between January 1, 2017 and March 31, 2017, were sent to counties May 5. ## **Transition Baseline**

Activities related to the SFY17 Transition Steps and Services and Transition Planning Conference (TPC) baseline analyses are underway. For counties included in the Transition analyses, the data cleaning period ended on May 8. All relevant deletions requests will be processed by May 15, and data re-entry following deletions is due May 19. Data will be extracted from Early Track May 22 and data inquiries will be sent out in early June.

## **FFY15 APR Clarifications Submitted and Posted**

The Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) recently provided states with comments regarding their FFY15 Annual Performance Report (APR) submissions and the annual clarification period was opened for states. Through the clarification period, states are given the opportunity to provide responses to OSEP comments and to edit their APRs in order to clarify content for OSEP. Ohio submitted the state's APR, with clarifications, on May 1. The updated version of the state's APR is posted on the EI website on the "Federal Reporting and Postings" tile of the Data and Monitoring page.

## **Reminder: Withdrawing from Trainings**

If you registered for a training on OhioTRAIN and find you cannot attend, it is very important that you withdraw from the training. Often, there are space limitations and waiting lists for trainings. When you withdraw in advance from a training, you are helping someone else attend.

To withdraw your registration:

1. Sign into your OhioTRAIN account .

5. Click the Withdraw button.
