# **PROGRAM UPDATES**

### August 1 Local Educational Agency (LEA) Notification

The quarterly LEA reporting requirement is coming up at the end of the month. Under Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 5123-10-02(L)(1)(b), the EI service coordination agency must notify the LEA (with parent consent) of children who will turn three within the next year by the first day of February, May, August, and November. This report is available in the EI Data System (EIDS) in both Excel and PDF formats. You may use either version, but please remember the following:

- The August 1 LEA report must be run no earlier than July 22 and no later than August 1. If the parent does not consent to share contact information with the LEA, "no" must be selected in EIDS in response to "Transition contact info shared with LEA:" on the most recent IFSP and the date the parent declined to share information must also be documented.
- It is expected that child information will be updated in a timely manner so that the LEA reports in EIDS are accurate.
- Only the sections of the report that are relevant to a particular LEA should be sent to that LEA, not the entire report.

• If you are not sure which LEA should be selected for a specific child, we encourage you to contact the relevant educational service center (ESC) for clarification. Contact information for all of the ESCs and public school districts, along with a map of districts, is available here: <u>http://education.ohio.gov/Topics/Data/Ohio-Educational-Directory-System-OEDS</u>

This quarterly report must be provided to the LEAs no later than August 1. The report does not need to be submitted to DODD, but we encourage you to keep a copy for your records. If you have any questions, please contact Melissa Courts at <u>melissa.courts@dodd.ohio.gov</u>.

## Documentation of Hearing Loss from the Ohio Department of Health (ODH)

Effective July 1, referrals from ODH for hearing loss will serve as confirmation of the diagnosed condition of hearing loss per Appendix C of OAC 5123-10-02. This will mirror the process used to document referrals from ODH for children with elevated blood lead levels (EBLL) and neonatal abstinence syndrome (NAS).

Since the Ohio Coalition for the Education of Children with Disabilities (OCECD) serves as ODH's contractor in determining if families with a child with hearing loss are interested in an EI referral, this process will include referrals from OCECD as well. *Contacts from both entities for these families will be listed in EIDS as from the "State Health Department."* If the contact is for hearing loss and the referral source in EIDS is "State Health Department," no further documentation is required to establish eligibility. Programs may choose to reach out to ODH and/or health professionals for additional information to support the assessment process for program planning as needed.

### SFY22 Timely Receipt of Services (TRS) Baseline

DODD sent customized reports with the children/services included in the TRS baseline analysis to participating counties on June 22. Applicable counties have until July 15 to make any needed edits to data, including requesting deletions.

# **R**ESOURCES AND **T**RAINING **OPPORTUNITIES**

### **Grant Management System Access Tips**

DODD is aware that some users may be experiencing difficulties logging in to the Grant Management System (GMS). We are providing these tips that some have found helpful in accessing GMS.

The most important step is to make sure you have a new browser when attempting to log into DODD applications. If you already have open tabs in a current browser, close all of them and open a new tab.

- Alternatively, you can open an Incognito browser.
  - This will avoid syncing issues if you are signed into other systems in your open tabs.

- You can create an Incognito tab by clicking the three dots in the upper right corner or by clicking CTRL + SHIFT + N in Google Chrome.
- Alternatively, you can open a tab or window in a different browser.
  - For example, you already have four tabs open in Google Chrome, so you create a tab in Firefox or Microsoft Edge instead.

You can log into DODD applications one of two ways:

## 1. Log in directly though the DODD website.

- a. Go to <u>www.dodd.ohio.gov</u> and select the person icon in the upper right corner.
- b. Log in with your DODD portal credentials this typically follows a *Last Name First Initial* format (such as *SmithJ*).
- c. When prompted, select the profile of the application / role you'd like to access. For example, you may see "*GMS Submitter*" by default, or choose a different option.
- d. Click the Applications button near the top of the screen, and then click the GMS tile.

## 2. Log in through MyOhio.

- a. Go to <u>www.myohio.gov</u> and enter your state ID #.
  - i. This should be the number associated with your DODD applications this number may be different from the 5X number you use to access other applications, such as OACSIS.
- b. Click My Apps, then click the My DODD tile to access DODD applications.
- c. Click the GMS tile.
