### About the 2025 Family Questionnaire and Results:

Families with children being served in Early Intervention on **March 1, 2025** were identified as questionnaire recipients. The “Number Sent” above represents all of those families, excluding those with an incorrect address or a child who was deceased. All survey items were rated on a five-point scale, with the following possible responses: Strongly Disagree, Disagree, Neither Agree nor Disagree, Agree, and Strongly Agree. All responses of ‘Agree’ or ‘Strongly Agree’ were considered to be a positive result. Please note that items with a small number of responses make it difficult to draw meaningful conclusions, either positive or negative. Responses were collected from the **end of May through mid-July 2025**.
