



# “All In” Early Intervention for Families

Is your child receiving Early Intervention services in a childcare setting? You are the most important member of your child's team! This resource helps you partner with your Early Intervention provider and your child's teacher to ensure the strategies used at home and in the classroom work together to help you reach the goals you and the team have established for your child.

## Concept

## How to Be “All In”

### **Collaborate**

Share what’s working well at home. Invite your child’s teacher to Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) meetings.

### **Reflect & Share**

Share progress or concerns. Let the team know what works well for your child at home.

### **Observe**

Notice the activities and routines that your child enjoys. Share your observations with the team.

### **Try It**

Practice the same strategies at home if possible. Be open to trying something new!

### **Joint Plan**

Help decide what will happen at home and at child care. Share updates on how the plan is going with the team.

### **Communicate**

Share updates with all team members with your preferred method of communication (e.g., e-mail, text, note).

### **Celebrate**

Notice and acknowledge effort and progress, big or small!
