

## EI Exit Reason Definitions

| Exit Reason   | Definition of Early Intervention Exit Reason   |
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| Child is deceased   | Includes all children who died before their third birthday while enrolled in EI  |
| Child does not meet eligibility requirements for EI services                    | Includes all children under the age of three who are not eligible for Early Intervention as determined by scores on a developmental evaluation (and when ICO was considered and it was not of the opinion of the evaluator(s) that the child had a delay in any domain)  |
| Child moved out of the state of Ohio  | Includes all children who moved out of Ohio before their third birthday  |
| Child screened and not suspected of having a disability                         | Includes all children under the age of three who had a developmental screening completed that indicated the child was not suspected of having a developmental delay or disability and the parent did not request an evaluation   |
| Child transitioned to part B services with an IEP prior to three years of age   | Includes all children under the age of three who are exited from EI due to transitioning to Part B, including the development of an IEP  |
| Child's IFSP outcomes are met and no additional IFSP outcomes are needed        | Includes all children under age three whose IFSP outcomes were met and there are no additional outcomes that need to be addressed  |
| Family moved out of contractor's geography within state                         | Includes all children who transferred to another county in Ohio before their third birthday  |
| Family no longer interested or able to participate in EI services at this time" | Includes all children under the age of three whose parents expressed they were no longer interested or able to participate in the Early Intervention program   |
| Loss of contact with family   | Includes all children under the age of three for whom Early Intervention personnel are unable to contact the family after previously being in contact, and after repeated, documented contact attempts   |
| Reached Age 3, Not Eligible for Part B, exit to other program                   | Includes all children who reached age three, were evaluated and determined not eligible for Part B, and were referred to other programs, which may include preschool learning centers, Head Start (but not receiving Part B services), and child care centers, and/or were referred for other services, which may include health and nutrition services, such as WIC |
| Reached Age 3, Not Eligible for Part B, exit with no referral                   | Includes all children who reached age three, were evaluated and determined not eligible for Part B, but were not referred to other programs  |
| Reached Age 3, Part B eligibility not determined                                | Includes all children who reached age three and their Part B eligibility was not determined  |
| Reached Age 3, Part B Eligible  | Includes all children who reached age three and were determined eligible to receive Part B services  |
| Referred to Help Me Grow less than 45 days prior to 3rd birthday                | Includes all children who were 45 or fewer days from their third birthday at the time of referral to Early Intervention  |
| The required evaluation or assessment was not completed                         | Includes all children under the age of three who did not have an eligibility determination, child assessment, or family-directed assessment completed  |
| Unable to contact family  | Includes all children under the age of three for whom Early Intervention personnel are <i>never</i> able to contact the family after repeated, documented contact attempts   |
