SFY19 Transition Analyses

Activities related to the SFY19 Transition Steps and Services and Transition Planning Conference analyses are underway. Counties included in the Transition analyses had until January 31 to review and clean up their data, including submission of any applicable deletion requests. Data were extracted on February 19. County inquiries, including Steps and Services Self Assessments as well as missing data requests and verification requests, as applicable, are scheduled to be sent to counties March 1.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

World Hearing Day

Sunday is World Hearing Day. On March 3 the World Health Organization (WHO) will draw attention to the importance of early identification and intervention for hearing loss.

The key messages for this event include:

- All people should check their hearing from time to time, especially those who are at a higher risk of hearing loss such as adults above 50 years, those working in noisy places, those listening to music at high volumes for long periods of time and those experiencing ear problems.
- Services for early identification and intervention should be made available through the health system.

The WHO will also launch a free app that allows people to check their hearing. The app can be used to raise awareness about the importance of hearing, encourage people to check their hearing regularly and practice safe listening, and allow health workers to check the hearing status of people in their communities

The first half of State Fiscal Year 2019 was a whirlwind for us as we implemented a Statewide Early Childhood Central Intake and Referral System. During those six months, Bright Beginnings and its seven regional partners were able to connect *over 20,000* pregnant women and families with young children to Early Intervention and Home Visiting services! We want to thank the Home Visiting and Early Intervention providers, and our colleagues at the Ohio Department of Health and Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities for your partnership throughout this process.

We also want you to be aware of some of the marketing strategies that will be rolled out over the next several months. These include billboards, commuter ads (public transportation audio advertising), parent and family magazine ads, placemat advertising, and grocery store advertising. These are targeted to communities based on high infant mortality rates, new and/or expanded home visiting programs, early intervention referral trends, and Amish populations. We are also planning many outreach activities including targeted outreach to all school districts in Ohio.

Our partnership with all of you is critically important. We want to help maintain the bridges already developed, enhance those that need added focus, and develop new connections to the critical services that your agencies provide.


