## Documenting Services in EIDS when Multiple Methods are Utilized

In EI Program Updates #2117, DODD recommended that EI services be listed on separate lines of the IFSP form grid if they are delivered with different methods. In these instances, the services should also be listed twice in the EI Data System (EIDS) to match the grid on the IFSP form. A service start date will be required for each separate entry, which should reflect the first date the service was delivered utilizing the specified method. Since the timely receipt of service (TRS) requirement applies to the first time the *service* is delivered, the earliest date of these will be used for all applicable TRS analyses.
