# SFY23 45-Day Timeline Baseline

DODD is in the process of verifying submitted records and requesting additional documentation, as needed. Results memos are scheduled to be sent by the end of May.

#### **SFY23 Transition Baseline**

Transition data have been extracted and inquiries will be sent to each participating county by May 11. Responses are due May 25.

#### Early Intervention Data System (EIDS) Exit Reason Update

In order to better align with the exit reasons on the Prior Written Notice of Exiting form (EI-10), the exit reason of "Child/Family not in need of services" in EIDS has been updated to "No need for IFSP outcomes at this time." This exit reason should only be chosen when the IFSP team, including the family, has completed the eligibility and assessment process and determined that no outcomes are needed for the child/family. This adjustment will be reflected on reports and in the records for all children previously exited with the reason "Child/Family not in need of services" and going forward in all records as a dropdown option on the exit page.

#### SFY24 EI Service Coordination Grant Webinar

On May 22 at 10:00am, DODD will provide an overview of the SFY24 EI service coordination grant. The webinar will highlight changes to this year's grant. The webinar will also discuss common issues that cause budgets to be denied. The target audience is EI Contract Managers,
