Updates to the EI Program Updates

## El Data System (EIDS) Changes for Revised El Rules

EIDS changes to ensure data collection is consistent with revised rules are being implemented the evening of June 28. ## SFY24 Timely Receipt of Services (TRS) Monitoring Baseline

DCY is in the process of verifying submitted records and requesting additional documentation, as needed. Results memos are scheduled to be sent July 24.

#### **JULY 2024 EI RULE UPDATES**

On June 10, the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR) approved changes to the Ohio Administrative Code governing early intervention services. The rule revisions become effective on July 4. Additionally, Ohio submitted an application to OSEP changing the lead agency for early intervention in Ohio to DCY effective July 1, 2024. These changes necessitate revisions and re-branding to all EI -related materials, training, and guidance. Given the short time frame between approval of the rules and the implementation date, it is not possible to complete all the needed revisions by July 4. Thank you for your patience as we work diligently to update the tools and resources you rely on for program implementation. Please see the information below regarding progress and estimated timelines for completion of all updates.

- General EI Inbox email address updated on homepage
- New EI logos uploaded for use on outreach materials, email signatures, etc.
- Color scheme updated to match "heart of it all" branding
- Early Intervention Rules 2019 page (and associated trainings) removed

#### Future work:

- English versions of the EI forms will be posted to the EI website by July 4. Translations to additional languages will be added as they become available in July.
- The EI service coordination credentialing page will be updated with new tools to assist with obtaining and maintaining the credentials by July 4.
- Guidance document page updates: all current documents will be removed as of July 4. Each document will be uploaded individually, once revised to reflect rule changes. This process should be completed for all documents by August 30.
- An updated EIDS data entry guide will be posted by July 4.
- Updated EI monitoring verification standards will be posted in July/August
- The Printed Materials page will be updated with new brochures in July/August.

## **Trainings**

#### El Orientation Modules

Most orientation modules are updated to align with EI rule revisions. Course EI-066, "Parent Rights and Procedural Safeguards in Early Intervention," and EI- 254, "Eligibility Basics- Train the Trainer," will be unavailable from July 15-August 15 to allow time for revisions to be made.

### Principles of Service Coordination (POSC) Modules

POSC modules will be unavailable as of July 15, 2024. Any El service coordinator currently completing any of these modules will need to finish prior to July 15, or their work will be lost. Service coordinators will have the option of requesting a three month extension of their credential expiration due to the required training modules being unavailable. The extension may be requested by emailing <a href="mailto:support@occrra.org">support@occrra.org</a>. The extension option will be in effect from July 15, 2024 through July 30, 2025.
