EI Supplemental Funding Memo

During recent state fiscal years when funding has been available, supplemental funding opportunities have been considered to support early intervention activities and services for urgent situations, support pilot programs, or to fund innovative practices that require additional financial resources. The funding has provided flexibility and access to funds for projects or initiatives that may not fit within the regular early intervention budget but are deemed critical or promising to address future growth or innovative approaches. DCY has suspended supplemental funding requests for the remainder of SFY25 as additional funds are not available. Please see the memo distributed to Early Intervention Service Coordination (EISC) agencies, EI Contract Managers, County Boards of Developmental Disabilities (CBDD) Superintendents, and county Family and Children First (FCFC) Coordinators February 28, for additional information.

State Fiscal Year 2025 (SFY25) Timely Receipt of Services (TRS) and Transition Baseline Analyses

The SFY25 TRS and Transition baseline activities are underway. Data were extracted on March 4, 2025, and compliance inquiries will be sent to all participating counties on March 25, 2025. All inquiries are due back to DCY by April 10, 2025.

SFY25 45-Day Baseline Analysis
