

Report Uses for Early Intervention Data

The following pages provide information about reports in Early Track that contain useful data relevant to Early Intervention (EI). Each page includes a description of included data, a screen shot of parameters, suggestions for potential uses, and a list of the fields included for a particular report. The potential uses are meant to simply provide suggestions, and do not encompass every possible use for the reports.

As the screen shots illustrate, many of the reports provide the options of "Data Extract" and "Data Summary" in the *Report Type* field. "Data Extract" refers to an excel file, and is ideal when a user needs to be able to sort, filter, or otherwise examine or analyze the data. As it produces a PDF file, the "Data Summary" often produces a more visually appealing report that may be better suited for sharing data.

Important Note: Report data are refreshed once a day, and therefore reflect data entered into the system as of the day prior to the report being run. There is a message in green at the top of the report tab that shows the exact date and time data were last refreshed. See screen shot below.

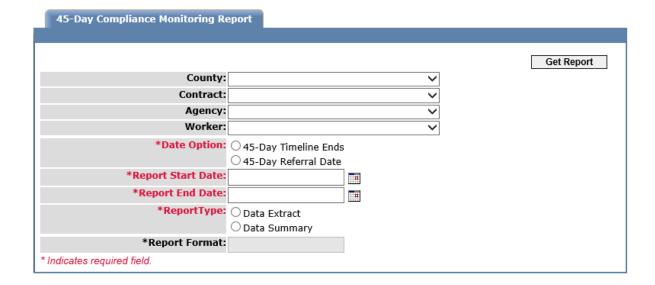

45-Day Compliance Monitoring Report

Includes all children within user-specified timeframe (referrals between specified dates or 45 day timelines ending between specified dates) whose record is open at least 45 days



Potential Uses:

- Monitor whether required components (Hearing Screening, Vision Screening, Nutrition Screening, Eligibility Determination, Child Assessment, Family Assessment, Need for Services (NFS), IFSP) have been completed within the required 45 days from program referral
- Review noncompliance reasons and ensure they are properly documented in case notes
- Identify patterns regarding timeliness among different Service Coordinators or Agencies

Known Issues:

- Eligibility sometimes incorrectly shows as missing when an evaluation shows a delay this
 appears to be limited to instances when the Bayley was used and the tool showed a delay only
 in expressive communication
- Child Assessments show as missing if the RBI or Observation are used
- Hearing, Nutrition, and Vision Screenings show as missing if a diagnosis related to hearing/vision/nutrition that occurred prior to the referral is used to meet this requirement



Child Outcomes Monitoring Report*

Expected to include the initial, most recent, and exit (if applicable) Child Outcomes Summary scores for all children with at least one Child Outcomes Summary rating completed during the user-specified time period



Potential Uses:

- Monitor scores and progress of children from their initial to their most recent Child Outcomes Summary
- Determine COS percentages as they would be reported in the Annual Performance Report (APR)
- Compare child outcomes across eligibility reasons

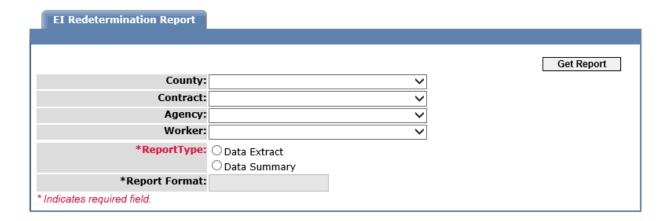

EI Redetermination

Includes all children served in EI at the time the report is run who will have redetermination due at some point before aging out, including children for whom redetermination is overdue



Potential Uses

- Monitor when redetermination is due for all children in specified county
- Determine for which children redetermination is overdue
- Identify patterns regarding timeliness among different Service Coordinators or agencies

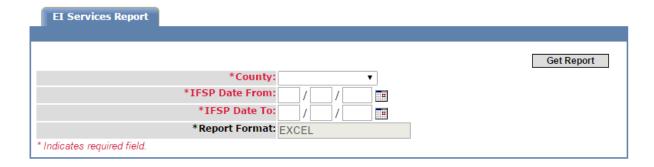

Includes all services for all IFSPs of children who had an IFSP within the user-specified time range



Potential Uses:

- Monitor TRS compliance
 - o Monitor whether new services added to IFSPs have started
 - o Review noncompliance reasons and ensure they are properly documented in case notes
 - o Identify patterns regarding timeliness among different Service Coordinators or Agencies
- Identify what services are being listed on IFSPs
- Examine frequency and amount of time services are delivered
- Examine location of service delivery
- Identify funding sources utilized for services
- Identify patterns among IFSP outcomes

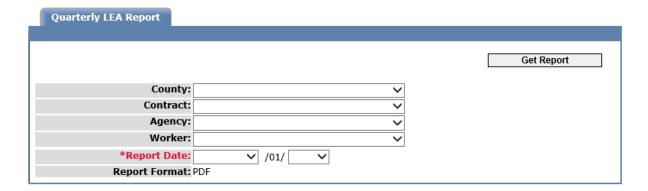

Quarterly LEA Report

Includes all children served in EI on the date of the report and who will be turning three within a year from the start of the quarter for which the report is run (February 1, May 1, August 1, or November 1), except children for whom parents have opted out of notification to the LEA



Potential Uses:

- Identify children who will potentially be transitioning within the next year
- Notify LEAs about children who are potentially eligible for Part B and may be transitioning in the coming months, as required by Ohio rule and federal regulations

Please Note: Because this report is required to be run and submitted to the LEA on a quarterly basis, but includes children turning three within a year from the report date, it is likely that children will be included on this report for multiple quarters

Known Issue:

• In some cases, Service Coordinator information is not being populated on this report



Service Coordinator Caseload

Includes all children (with and without an established Need for Services) on specified Service Coordinator(s) caseload(s) on the date the report is run



Potential Uses:

- Identify which children are on caseloads of particular Service Coordinators
- Identify which children have been determined eligible and which have not
- Determine when the most recent IFSP occurred and when the next IFSP is due

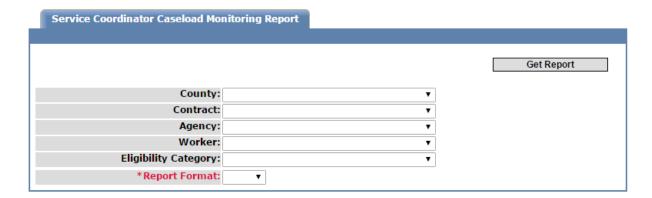

Service Coordinator Caseload Monitoring Report

Includes all children on the specified Service Coordinator(s) caseload(s) on the date the report is run who have an established NFS*



Potential Uses:

- Identify which children are on caseloads of particular Service Coordinators
- Determine whether particular elements, such as the TPC and screenings, have been completed for each child
- Determine when the most recent IFSP occurred and when the next IFSP is due
- Identify patterns among Service Coordinators regarding whether required components have been completed

Known Issues:

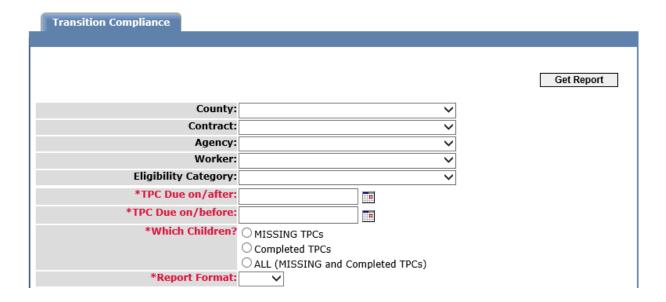
- For the "N/A No interventionist needed to meet transition outcome" and "Service not yet
 coordinated" options, start dates are not relevant, yet if those are the service options chosen,
 they are still showing as "awaiting a service start date or noncompliance reason" in the IFSP
 State column
- Only IFSPs after the most recent NFS are showing in the Initial IFSP and Most Recent IFSP fields

Transition Compliance

Includes all children with Transition Planning Conferences due between user-specified dates



Potential Uses:

- Monitor whether Transition Planning Conferences have been completed
- Review noncompliance reasons and ensure they are properly documented in case notes
- Identify patterns regarding timeliness among different Service Coordinators or Agencies

Known Issue:

• In January of 2015, a business rule was added in the system to reflect that there is not a TPC requirement for children referred to EI less than 90 days prior to their third birthday – in doing so, there is no longer an NCR prompt when TPCs are entered for these children. However, the Transition Compliance report is still showing these TPCs as late, and includes no NCR since that is no longer relevant

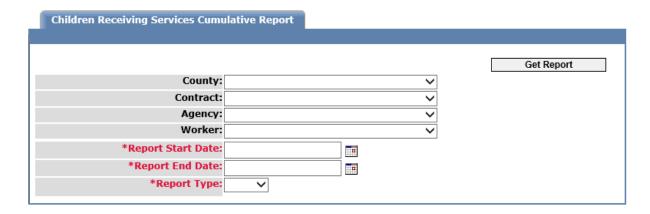

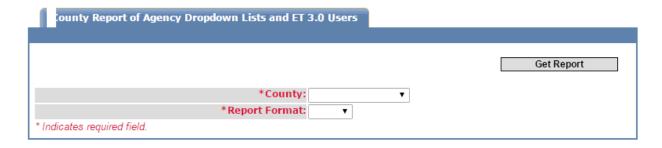

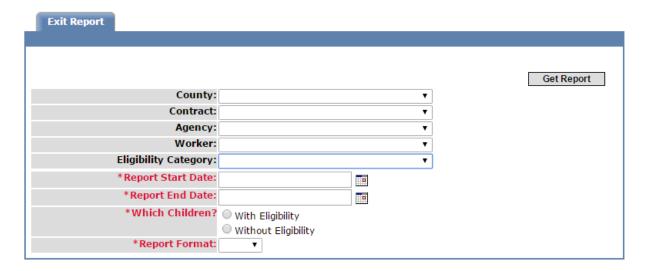

Potential Uses:

- Track status and outcome of referrals (e.g., how many/what percentage of children had an established Need for EI Services, how many children went on to be served in EI)
- Examine the exit reasons of children who did not go on to be served in EI
- Identify patterns among referral outcomes based on referral source type
