

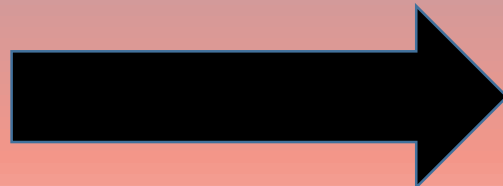

The RBI and Ecomap: how functional outcomes follow

What was the impetus for this outcome – RBI or evaluation?

Was it talked about during the RBI? Were supports drawn from ECOMAP?

Does outcome emphasize the child/parent participating in a routine/time of day?

Is it building the parent/caregiver confidence and competence?

Is it important to the family?
