PSP: Key Concepts

Key Principle #6: The family's priorities, needs, and interests are addressed most appropriately by a primary provider who represents and receives team and community support. Core Team: SC, DS, PT, OT, SLP

PSP selected as best match for child/family

Other providers support PSP via consultation and/or joint visits

Regular team meetings

PSP changes as infrequently as possible


