My service coordinator has explained the "system of payments" rule and any potential costs that I may incur when using my private insurance to pay for Early Intervention services, such as co-payments, deductibles, premiums or long term costs such as the loss of benefits because of annual or lifetime health insurance coverage caps of the insurance policy.
